The district educates more than 2,500 students ranging from pre-kindergarten to 12th grade and employs more than 400 staff members. The district has five schools, including three elementary schools, a junior high school, and a high school. The diverse community of Harvard has a deep, rich history and has supported public education since 1859.

Its mission is to produce a community of learners by cultivating academic, social, and emotional skills to maximize each student's potential.
